<b>Worfield Golf Club</b> <i>(I am a member here)</i>	18 holes 6801yds Par 73 SSS 73	5 miles (10 mins)	Opened in 1999, it was rated highly in a recent golf magazine survey & is one of the best new courses in the Midlands.
<b>Bridgnorth Golf Club</b>	18 holes 6673 yds Par 73 SSS 72	2 miles (10 mins)	A well laid out parkland course on the banks of the River Severn.
<b>Chesterton Valley Golf Club</b>	18 holes with 27 tees: White 3385 yds Par 37 Blue 2853 yds Par 34 Yellow 2428 yds Par 33 Ladies 2703 yds Par 37	6 miles (15 mins)	A very interesting & testing course. The fantastic drainage & wonderful views have quickly made this a very popular choice.
<b>Cleobury Mortimer Golf Club</b>	Three 9 hole loops: Deer Park - 3167 yds Par 70 SSS 70 Foxes Run - 2960 yds Par 69 SSS 69 Badgers Sett - 3271 yds Par 71 SSS 71	10 miles (20 mins)	Set in 200 acres of gently undulating countryside with spectacular views west to the Clee Hills & east to the Wyre Forest, which provides the natural boundary to the course.
<b>Shropshire Golf Club</b>	Three 9 hole loops: Blue course 3286yds, Par 35 SSS 35 Silver Course 3303yds, Par 36 SSS 36 Gold Course: 3334yds, Par 36 SSS 36	17 miles (25 mins)	Covered floodlit practice range, 12 hole pitch & putt, 18 hole family putting green.

Enville Golf Club	Highgate Course 18 holes, 6556yds, Par 72 SSS72 Lodge Course 18 holes 6217yds Par 70 SSS 70	10 miles (20 mins)	Easy Walking on 2 excellent parkland/moorland courses. British Open qualifying course.
Hawkstone Park	Hawkstone 18 holes, 6465yds, Par 72 SSS 72 Windmill 18 holes 6655yds, Par 72 SSS 72	28 Miles (45 mins)	Amidst 300 acres of historical grounds, Sandy Lyle learned his game on the Hawkstone Course. The Windmill Championship Course, constructed around the old Weston Course, has 8 American style holes with a lot of water, sand & huge greens.

Name	Description	Distance	Other Info
Lilleshall Hall Golf Club	18 Holes 5813 yds Par 68 course	18 miles (30 mins)	A fairly open parkland front nine and a tight back nine amongst beautiful mature trees. No par 5's but the course is protected against low score by small undulating greens. Designed by Harry Colt who designed Wentworth and the home course of Peter Baker. Very good test of golf.
Llanymynech Golf Club	18 holes 6968 yds Par 71	43 miles (55mins)	Where Ian Woosman learnt to play golf. Perched on top of a prominent hill and surrounded by sheer cliff. On the 4th hole you tee off in Wales and putt out in England. You return to Wales on the 7th tee.
Ludlow Golf Club	18 holes 6277 yds Par 70	20 miles (30 mins)	Uniquely designed around the famous Ludlow Racecourse. The course is set in unspoilt heath land based on a sandy type of soil which provides lovely springy fairways and superb year-round greens.
Oswestry Golf Club	18 Holes 6051 yds Par 70	36 miles (45 mins)	Set in gently undulating mature parkland, designed by James Braid (renowned for his use of two tier greens). The free draining soils ensure year round play.
Swindon (West Midlands) Golf Club	Old Course 18 holes, 6091 yds, Par 71 SSS69. New Course 9 holes, 1135 yds, Par 27	12 miles (20 mins)	Attractive undulating woodland/parkland course with spectacular views.
Telford Golf & Country Club	18 holes 6754yds Par 71 SSS 71	7 miles (15 mins)	Rolling parkland course with easy walking. Three lakes & large sand traps are hazards to the fine greens
Wrekin Golf Club	18 holes 5699yds Par 67 SSS 66	12 miles (20 mins)	Upland course with rewarding views.
